## 4. Applicant Eligibility

### (1) Nationality

- Applicant and their parents must hold foreign citizenship.

\* **Korean citizens, including those who hold dual citizenship, are NOT eligible to apply.**

\* **Applicants and their parents who had previously held Korean citizenship must submit the document of the renunciation of their Korean citizenship.**

### (2) Age

- Applicants must be under 40 years of age as of Sep. 1st, 2017 (born after Sep. 1st, 1977).
- An applicant who qualifies ALL conditions below is eligible to apply as long as he or she is under 45 years of age as of September 1, 2017 (born after September 1, 1972):
  - He or she must be working as a professor at the time of applying; and
  - He or she is a citizen of one of the countries below.

### (3) Degree Requirements

- Applicants must hold or be an expected recipient of a Bachelor's or Master's degree as of August 31st, 2017. (Applicant eligibility will be rescinded if applicant fails to obtain the appropriate degree by August 31st, 2017).
  - ※ Applicants who apply for the Master's program must hold a Bachelor's degree or a diploma that is equivalent to or higher than a Bachelor's degree.
  - ※ Applicants who apply for the Doctoral program must hold a Master's degree or a diploma that is equivalent to or higher than a Master's degree.
- Applicants who have completed a Bachelor's, Master's or Doctoral degree in Korea are NOT eligible to apply.
- Applicants who have been enrolled at Korean universities as exchange students are eligible to apply.
- A former KGSP scholar who graduated or are expected to graduate as of August 31, 2017 is eligible to apply under the following conditions:
  - He/ she is allowed to apply only via Embassy Track; and
  - The re-application is allowed only once.
- Applicants who are expecting to obtain the relevant required degree or diploma by August 31st, 2017 must submit a certificate of degree or diploma expectation, and submit the official certificate of degree or diploma to NIIED by August 31st, 2017. (If not, disqualified for this program)

### (4) Grades

- Applicants must maintain a grade point average (GPA) higher than any ONE of the followings:
  - 2.64 on a 4.0 scale;
  - 2.80 on a 4.3 scale;
  - 2.91 on a 4.5 scale;
  - 3.23 on a 5.0 scale; or
  - Score percentile: 80%

- Please refer to the Appendix 4 for the GPA conversion table.
- Any applications with a GPA below the threshold above will be automatically disqualified and discarded.
- It is required to submit an official document issued by the applicant's alma mater describing the university's evaluation system as well as the applicant's academic achievement in any ONE of the following cases:
  - An applicant's transcript does not include information on GPA, marks or score percentile; or
  - The grades on an applicant's transcript are difficult to be converted into any one of the GPA criteria mentioned above.

\* If an applicant cannot refer to the attended institution, he/she can use a transcript conversion service at <http://www.wes.org>, or <http://www.foreigncreditiats.com>. Please mind that these websites are fee-based service and SNU will only accept an officially converted transcript by them, but not a sample one.

#### (5) Health

- Applicants must be in good health, both mentally and physically, to stay in Korea for an extended period of time.
- Applicants must submit the Personal Medical Assessment, or Form 6, at the time of applying.
- All applicants who pass the 2<sup>nd</sup> round of selection must submit the results of the Comprehensive Medical Examination conducted by a licensed physician or a doctor.
- All of the following persons will be disqualified and their scholarships will be canceled:
  - Applicants who are tested positive on drugs; and
  - Applicants with serious health concerns to an extent that they are unable to pursue their studies for an extended period of time in Korea.
- Applicants with disability who meet the above criteria are eligible to apply.

#### (6) Restrictions

- Those who had withdrew from the scholarship after being selected as KGSP scholars in previous years are NOT eligible to apply.

#### (7) Preferred Qualities

- Applicants who have Korean proficiency(TOPIK) or English proficiency(TOEFL, TOEIC, IELTS) may be given preference.
- Applicants in the field of natural science, technology, and engineering might be given preference.
- The faculty members at a higher education institution from countries that receive Korea's Official Development Assistance (ODA) might be given preference.
- Descendants of the Korean War veterans receive additional 5% of the total marks during the selection reviews.

## 6. Instructions for application submission

### (1) Arrangement of the required documents

- One set of original documents listed above.
- A set of documents submitted must be combined by a pair of tongs or pincers  
(Do not use stapler to bind them)
- The application documents must be arranged in the same order as written on the 'Requirements'.
- Individual certificates or documents must be in order of original one front, and notarized one back.
- Each required document must be numbered and labeled on the top right corner as the following.  
(Example: ⑦ Bachelor's Diploma)

(2) The forms and address

## 7. Important Notes for All Applicants

- ☒ All documents should be in **English or Korean**. Documents in any other language should be accompanied by a notarized English or Korean translation issued by the country in which the document was originally produced.
- ☒ Original documents should be submitted. Should they be unavailable, however, copies must be **authenticated** by the issuing institution confirming that they are the same with the originals.
- ☒ In case of submitting photocopied documents, applicants MUST **have the copies notarized or apostilled** and then submit the notarized or apostilled copies. For any documents that cannot be reissued, applicants are advised to submit notarized or apostilled copies of the original.

- Please note, changes and/or cancellations will not be permitted after the completion of documentation submission.
- Incomplete or incorrect information presented in the application documents may lead to rejection of the application by Selection Committee and scholarship will be rescinded even after entry into Korea.
- Write the exact title of the programs offered for admission from <Appendix 1>.
- The University and/or the desired program of study cannot be changed after submission.
- Additional documents may be required from the applicant, based on the policy of the specific college or department.
- Dual applications are not accepted. Applicants must apply for this program via one Organization (Korean Embassy, Domestic University and Korean adoption association). If the applicant receives recommendation from more than one University or Organization, he/she will be disqualified.

- The recommendation letters must be written by two different recommenders, who can give assessment on the applicant's academic abilities. Applicants must get sealed recommendation letters from their recommenders. Letters with broken seals at the time of applying will be considered invalid.
- The applicant's name on the application form MUST be identical to the applicant's passport name.
- The scores of the language proficiency test must be valid at the time of applying.
- As for the submission of the published papers and awards, applicants are allowed to submit photocopies.
- Submitted documents will not be returned to the applicants.
- Details of individual admission decisions for applicants cannot be disclosed.
- Applicants must accurately complete the health checklist truthfully. All successful candidates must take a comprehensive medical exam when its' orientation. In accordance with the requirements of the Korea Immigration Service and the KGSP Program, the candidates who are judged to be physically unfit for this program will not be accepted.

## 8. Selection Criteria

- (1) Evaluation will be based on the submitted documents including the self-introduction essay, study plan, recommendation letters, transcript and any other additional supplementary materials. Based on the documents submitted, applicant's academic ability, language ability, aspirations for study abroad, potential societal contribution, and anticipated contribution towards the relationship between the two countries will be evaluated for the purposes of selection.
- (2) Applicants selected from the document review process will be notified to attend an in-person or a phone interview.

## 9. Duration of Korean Government Scholarship Program

- Master's (Sep. 1, 2017 ~ Aug. 31, 2020) : 1yr. of Korean language study + 2yrs of Master's
- Doctoral (Sep. 1, 2017 ~ Aug. 31, 2021) : 1yr. of Korean language study + 3yrs of Doctoral
- ※ The scholarship period for the degree program cannot and will not be extended
- ※ KGSP scholars with advanced TOPIK levels (Levels 5 and 6)
  - Those who have the advanced levels at the time of applying will be exempt from the 1-year Korean language program. The exempt period will be deducted from the total scholarship period, down to 2 years for Master's degrees and to 3 years for Doctoral degrees.
  - Those who achieve the advanced levels on TOPIK within the first 6 months of the language program will be exempt from the Korean language program and must start their degree programs in the following semester. The exempt period will be deducted from the total scholarship period, down to 2.5 years for Master's degrees and 3.5 years for Doctoral degrees.
  - Scholars who are exempted from taking the Korean language course must take their degree course starting from September 1<sup>st</sup>, 2017.



## 10. Korean Language Course

- 1 year of Korean Language Study is required for all recipients of Korean Government Scholarship at the designated language institution.
- If the student fails to obtain TOPIK score of level 3 and or above at the end of the given year, his/her scholarship recipient status and the offered admission by SNU will be rescinded.
- Language Institution: Student will be assigned to one of the Institutions designated by NIIED. The main language institution placement principle is different area from the finally chosen university of scholars in order to provide a chance of exploring variable Korean cultures and immerse on Korean language learning with professional environments for scholars.

## 11. Scholarship Payment Details

- Airfare
  - Entry to Korea: an economy class flight ticket to Korea
  - Return flight: an economy class flight ticket from Korea to KGSP scholar's home country
  - The airfare for entry will NOT be provided to scholars who have resided in Korea from the time of applying and on.
  - The return flight is available only for the KGSP scholars who successfully complete their degree coursework.
  - The return flight is NOT offered for those who withdraw from the scholarship.
  - Any fees incurred in the domestic travel within a KGSP scholar's home country are NOT covered.
  - International travel insurance is NOT covered.
  - The flight tickets for the Chinese and Czech KGSP scholars will be prepared and provided by the Chinese and the Czech governments, according to the agreements with the Korean government.
- Settlement Allowance: 200,000 KRW
- Monthly Allowance
  - Degree Program (Master's or Doctoral): 900,000 KRW
- Research Allowance
  - Liberal Arts and Social Science Degrees: 210,000 KRW per semester
  - Science, Technology and Engineering Degrees: 240,000 KRW per semester
- Language Training Fees: Fully covered
- Degree Tuition: Fully covered
  - Tuition up to 5 million KRW is covered by NIIED, and the amount that exceeds 5 million is covered by the host university.
  - The KGSP scholars are waived from the admission fees of the universities.
- Dissertation Printing Fee Reimbursement
  - The actual cost of printing as written on the receipt will be reimbursed.
  - The maximum amount is 500,000 KRW for degrees in Liberal Arts and Social Science and 800,000 KRW for degrees in Science, Technology and Engineering.
- Medical Insurance: 20,000 KRW per month
- Korean Proficiency Grants: 100,000 KRW per month
  - This special funding is available for KGSP scholars with levels 5 and 6 on TOPIK.
- Scholarship Completion Grants: 200,000 KRW
  - It is offered for the KGSP scholars who return to their home countries after completing their degree coursework under the scholarship.

- It is not offered for the KGSP scholars who decide to stay in Korea after the completion of their degree coursework.
