## About the **Application period Scholarship** Only intended for Fall semesters Value of the award Awards cover full tuition fees for 2 years (4 semesters) and provide a grant for living expenses (KRW 600,000 per month), a round-trip airfare up to KRW1, 000,000, and Korean classes up to 2 sessions. **Duration** Scholarships are renewed semi-annually for up to 4 semesters on the basis of academic requirements. Students must maintain a grade point average of at least 3.0. to continue benefits from the scholarship. **Application** Admission Applications: Submit required documents to the Office of Admissions after completing the on-line application.
